- between the ages of 17-24
- a U.S. citizen
- reside, work or attend school in Illinois for the last 6 months
- meet character criteria as set forth by the Miss America Organization
- be in reasonably good health to meet the job requirements
- must be able to meet the time commitment and responsibilities

A \$100 donation to Children's Miracle Network, the official platform of the Miss America Organization, must also be raised to compete.

Competition categories include, Private Interview, Talent, Lifestyle and Fitness in Swimsuit, Evening Wear and On-Stage Question.

The titleholder of Miss Metro East will compete in the next Miss Illinois competition in June. All contestants must be available for Spring Forum and Miss Illinois Week.
